Introduction:

In response to training needs in Central and South America, on August 6, 2008, the Clinica Reina Sofia Endoscopy Training Center and the Clinica Universitaria Colombia Endoscopy Training Center were inaugurated in Bogotá, Colombia.

Clínica Riena Sofia has obtained significant recognition in digestive endoscopy both in Colombia and abroad, and a subspecialty program is being created under the auspice of a new medical school, Unisanitas.

Geography: Colombia is located in the northern region of South America, making the Center accessible for Central America countries as well as other countries located in the north of South America. The Center is housed in 2 University Clinics performing 2500 endoscopy procedures a month.

The Bogotá TC has three lines of training:

- 1. Fellow in Gastroenterology and Endoscopy
- 2. Fellow in Endosonography
- 3. Training in advanced therapeutic Colonoscopy.
- 4. ERCP Complement (NEW)

The Training Center is well recognized in Latin America; doctors from Venezuela, Peru, Costa Rica, Argentina, Uruguay, Bolivia, and Mexico have all applied for training.

Bogotá is a nice city with nice weather (mean 18°Celsius) with many places to stay near the Training Center.

Main Objectives / Goals:

The main objectives of the Bogotá Training Center include the provision of complementary endoscopy training, training in therapeutic endoscopy, training in endoscopic EUS, training in new technologies, and research on new developments in endoscopy.

The geographic areas targeted for training includes Colombia, Central America and the Andean region.

Facilities:

Digestive Endoscopy Unit:

- Two adult and one paediatric endoscopy rooms
- One gastrointestinal physiology room
- Recovery room for sedated patients
- Dedicated area for equipment disinfection


ERCP Suite with digital radiology support

Experimental Animal Suite in development.




In Reina Sofia Clinic we have two EUS rooms for training in Endosonography and one room for training in colonoscopy.
